If the teeth are not in contact with the plate, it will produce an elongated image

Canine Full Mouth Overview

Make sure your angle guide is positioned midline to the plate as this will make your beam central and evenly cast your X-ray across the entire plate for a complete image

In some breeds, you may want additional images of the upper canines
